3. Tractor accident under the Krasnik. Two children in the tractor cab – case study

There were four people in the tractor - two brothers aged 26 and 27, and two boys aged 7 and 15.

All of them were sitting in a tractor that rolled over while driving. The farmer did not maintain safety at work.

Nevertheless, there will be an investigation to expose people to immediate danger of loss of life and health, because there were more people in the cab than there should be.

The penal code for this act provides for a prison sentence of up to 3 years.

The men who drove the tractor were sober.
