## Case Study 3

### Registered work accident

#### **What was the employer supposed to do?**

The employer should have carried out a risk assessment to determine:

##### **1. What could happen?**

- injury to the operator, as the machine has a large number of rotating and sharp parts

##### **2. What is the probability that any of these things will happen?**

**High** when taking into account:

- that the employee does not use personal protective equipment when maintaining the forage wagon, as he has been informed that he should use gloves when maintaining the machine
- a large number of rotating and sharp parts on the machine

##### **3. What are the possible consequences (binding)?**

- injury (potential scratches, cuts)

##### **4. What control measures should he take if he had assessed the situation in advance?**

- develop a safe work procedure for changing the blades on the forage wagon cutter
- in education and training in the field of occupational safety and health, increase the emphasis on the identification and assessment of hazards and the adoption of safety measures
- intensify control over the use of personal protective equipment
